

**ORDINANCE NO. MH 02-06**

**An Ordinance Establishing A Town Beautification Fund**

Whereas, the Town Council (the "Council") of the Town of Meridian Hills, Indiana (the "Town") established an ad hoc Town Planning Committee ("the Committee"); and

Whereas, the Committee surveyed the residents of the Town for their input and suggestions for improving the aesthetics and atmosphere of the Town; and

Whereas, while many good ideas were brought forth, the funding of such improvements cannot be a priority of the Council so long as its revenue from various tax sources is needed for basic Town services; and

Whereas, it has been suggested that some residents of the Town may be interested in donating to a fund for the purpose of beautification of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Meridian Hills, Indiana:

Section 1. There is hereby created a "Town Beautification Fund" for the purpose of accepting contributions of any sort and to be expended for the beautification and aesthetic improvement of the Town.

Section 2. All prior ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, to the extent of each inconsistency only, as of the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and such publication as is required by law.
